

# Roller Operator

## Job Description:

- Operate various types of asphalt rollers to perform various types of work such as, but not limited to, obtaining compaction, ride ability, and a smooth finish on all types mixes and thickness of asphalt lay down.

## Job Duties & Responsibilities:

- Operating an asphalt roller
- Must be able to perform walk around inspections of equipment before operation and at the end of shift.
- Being versatile with other types of heavy equipment is a plus.
- Ability to understand roller patterns and techniques of asphalt paving to obtain a finish product. Ability to learn and abide by proven paving techniques.
- Maintain a good attendance and safety record.
- Ability to abide by precise instructions and strict but necessary safety rules and policies.
- Must be a reliable/trustworthy team player
- Overtime work is required.

## Tasks Essential to Job Functions:

- Occasional standing and walking required.
- Ability to work long hours of time while sitting in the operator's station.
- Ability to operate equipment at recommended speeds and peaks of operation.
- Must be productive during each shift and be willing to meet the goals that are set.
- Ability to develop a mental picture of the finished product and then execute the necessary skills to productively complete each required task.
- **Climbing:** Ladder climbing is performed to enter/exit the equipment or machinery.
- **Crawling:** Occasionally crawls to check equipment/machinery for safe day-to-day operation and for general maintenance needs.
- **Bending/Stooping/Crouching:** Forward torso bending is required to reach the hand controls of machinery or during inspection of the equipment.
- **Squatting/Kneeling:** May be occasionally required during general inspection of machinery/equipment.

## Work Environment

- Work is performed outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Work environment periodically exposes the employees to high levels of noise, grease, and dust that is typically associated with a construction

- project.
- Employee regularly works near heavy equipment and moving machinery.
  - Work may involve a variety of substances commonly found on construction sites such as form oil, grease, curing compounds, gasoline, diesel fuel and ready mixed concrete.

**Required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):**

Will be required to properly wear personal protective equipment (PPE) including but not limited to:

- Hard hat
- Safety Vest
- Ear plugs
- Work gloves
- Steel-toe boots

**Education:**

- High school or equivalent (Preferred)
- Valid Driver's License and able to pass drug screening
